Enrolments

- The team is just coping with very high levels of enrolment queries. Response times are out to three days plus and we don't expect an improvement in that for several weeks.
- Academic progression outcome will be applied in two weeks' time, so if students are discussing options with staff, please be aware that we need students to take action on interviews and responses to suspensions and exclusions in the next two weeks.
- Several courses - B Business, B Creative Media and B Communication – have 'placeholder majors' showing for students admitted via TISC. There is a process to contact these students asking them to nominate their real major within these courses. If staff are asked about it, students should lodge a request in MyAnswers nominating their real major.

Fees

- Fees for the first half of the year are in place and calculating with no known errors. Sponsorships are not yet in place, but should be this week.
- The International Welcome Scholarships are being delivered in a different way for 2018, and students are seeing the full amount displayed in their invoices.
