

How to use this document

All postgraduate courses at Murdoch University have a minimum English entry requirement. There are several postgraduate courses with higher minimum English entry requirements. All requirements are outlined in this document.

IMPORTANT NOTES

1. valid for two years from the date of testing
2. this can be shown by producing evidence that they have been studying and/or working in a country where English is the official language. You will need to provide references e.g. work experience letters/academic transcripts. You will also need to provide copies of passports and/or visas to prove duration of residency.
3. Successful completion of: a) Secondary school studies to the equivalent of Australian Year 12, with a minimum of four years' study at secondary school or equivalent; and b) A bachelor degree or higher degree, with a minimum of three years' equivalent full time study; where i. The secondary school and degree studies were completed at educational institutions in Australia, Canada, Ireland, New Zealand, South Africa, the United Kingdom and/or the United States of America; and ii. English was the language of instruction at these educational institutions; and iii. The study was undertaken while you were living in the country where your degree was awarded and your schooling was completed. 4. Successful completion of: a) Secondary school studies either to the equivalent of Australian Year 10 or Year 12; and b) At least 10 years of primary and/or secondary schooling; where i. English was the language of instruction at the school or schools; and ii. The schooling was undertaken and completed in Australia, Canada, Ireland, New Zealand, South Africa, the United Kingdom and/or the United States of America; and iii. You were living in Australia, Canada, Ireland, New Zealand, South Africa, the United Kingdom and/or the United States of America throughout your period of schooling.either Australia, Canada, New Zealand, Republic of Ireland, South Africa, United Kingdom or United States of America, including at least two years between years 7 and 12.
4. Regardless of Murdoch University's English Language requirements, international applicants should be aware that they must still satisfy the Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP) English language requirements for visa applications.
5. For example if you have an ELICOS course from a University in Western Australia, the ELICOS course has to meet entry into that University.
6. Regardless of Murdoch University's English Language requirements, ALL applicants should be aware of the English registration requirements for their - this will apply and not limited to Psychology, Nursing, Counselling, Education/Teaching, Migration Law.

PREVIOUS STUDY AT A TERTIARY LEVEL (ENGLISH AS THE MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION)

Medium of instruction may be considered only if the previous study in the English language medium of instruction has been completed at a university level (equivalent to AQF level 7 or higher) within five years prior to the date the applicant will start the course at Murdoch University. This limitation period does not apply to applicants who:

a. meet the minimum institutional English language requirements AND

b. can show evidence that they have used English as the primary mode of communication in the time between achieving the English Language Competency and commencing studies at Murdoch University.

If there is a history of failure, a written statement should be provided because this may be an indication of insufficient English Language Competency.

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY TESTS

1. English Proficiency Tests must be Academic only. General and vocational tests are not acceptable.
2. English Proficiency test results are valid for two years from the date of testing, however may be used for entry until the next immediate semester intake. This limitation period does not apply to applicants who:
- meet the minimum institutional English language requirements AND
 - can show evidence that they have used English as the primary mode of communication in the time between achieving the English Language Competency and commencing studies at Murdoch University,
 - completed secondary studies under the GCE Advanced, Advanced Subsidiary (AS) and Ordinary (GCSE) Level or IB curriculum with the required results.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE COURSES (ACADEMIC)

A successfully completed approved ELICOS result may be considered only if it has been completed within one year prior to the date the applicant will start the course at Murdoch University. This limitation period does not apply to applicants who:

a. meet the minimum institutional English language requirements [AND](#),

b. can show evidence that they have used English as the primary mode of communication in the time between achieving the English Language Competency and commencing studies at Murdoch University (this can be shown by producing evidence that they have been studying and/or working in a country where English is the official language).
