

How to use this document

The qualifications in this document are listed in six categories. Scroll to the relevant pages for details of each category.

Example: If you completed English at High School, go to the Secondary Education category, find the country where you completed your study, then check the English requirements for the course you want to study.

All undergraduate courses at Murdoch University have a minimum English entry requirement. The Bachelor of Law, Bachelor of Nursing, Bachelor of Veterinary Science and Bachelor of Education have higher minimum English entry requirements. All requirements are outlined in this document.

IMPORTANT NOTES

1. Regardless of Murdoch University's English Language requirements, international applicants should be aware that they must still satisfy the Department of Home Affairs (formerly Department of Immigration and Border Protection) English language requirements for visa applications.
2. Regardless of Murdoch University's English Language requirements, ALL applicants should be aware of the professional registration English requirements for their course - this applies, and is not limited to Psychology, Nursing, Counselling, Education/Teaching.

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY TESTS

English Proficiency Tests must be Academic only. General and vocational tests are not acceptable. Test results are valid for two (2) years from the date of testing, however may be used for entry until the next immediate semester intake. This limitation period does not apply to applicants who:

- meet the minimum institutional English language requirements AND
- can show evidence that they have used English as the primary mode of communication in the time between achieving the English Language Competency and commencing studies at Murdoch University.

*English-speaking country - recognised countries include Australia, Canada, New Zealand, Republic of Ireland, South Africa, United Kingdom and United States of America.

** For Bachelor of Nursing, a combination of two IELTS results, taken within 6 months apart, may be acceptable

A successfully completed approved High School English result may be considered only if it has been completed within five (5) years prior to the date the applicant will start the course at Murdoch University. This limitation period does not apply to applicants who:

- meet the minimum institutional English language requirements **AND**
- can show evidence that they have used English as the primary mode of communication in the time between achieving the English Language Competency and commencing studies at Murdoch University (this can be shown by producing evidence that they have been studying and/or working in a country where English is the official language).
