

## International Cricket Excellence Program 2020 - Terms and Conditions

1. The International Cricket Bursary 2020 (**Cricket Bursary**) is offered by Murdoch University (**Murdoch** or **University**) of 90 South Street, Murdoch, Western Australia and the Western Australian Cricket Association (**WACA**) of [PO Box 6045, East Perth, Western Australia].
2. The Cricket Bursary will commence from 1 January 2020 and will be on offer until 31 December 2020.
3. By entering the Cricket Bursary, Applicants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.

### Terms and Conditions for Entry

4. To enter the Cricket Bursary, Applicants are required to provide the following to Murdoch:
  - a. An application via the International Cricket Program webpage [<https://murdoch.edu.au/study/international-cricketing-opportunities>] that includes a cover letter and resume detailing their cricket experience, and two references from the Applicant's home cricket club or association.
5. Applicant(s) will only be eligible to the Cricket Bursary if the Applicant(s) satisfies the following requirements:
  - a. The Applicant has received an unconditional letter of offer from Murdoch to enrol in a Murdoch coursework course;
  - b. The Applicant satisfies all Murdoch entry conditions to enrol in the Murdoch course;
  - c. The Applicant is classified as a Murdoch international student and has paid their fees to Murdoch in full for their respective course;
  - d. The Student has been granted an Australian student visa pursuant to the *Migration Act 1958* (Cth);
  - e. The Applicant will be commencing their studies at one of Murdoch's Western Australian campuses in 2020;
  - f. The Applicant plays cricket at a high standard and is a current member of an international cricket club or association; and
  - g. The Applicant can provide two references from the Applicant's home cricket club or association demonstrating that the Applicant is a high-level cricket player.
6. Following the Applicant completing the digital application pursuant to clause 4, the Applicant will be required to provide personal details including name, email address and telephone number, including details of their references.
7. Murdoch is not liable for late, lost or misdirected entries.
8. Current Murdoch students and employees are not eligible to enter.
9. Entry to the Cricket Bursary is free.
10. Entrants will be responsible for all costs associated with entering the Cricket Bursary, including but not limited to mobile telephone charges.
11. By entering the Cricket Bursary, the Applicant agrees that they are over the age of 18 years, or if under the age of 18 years, have their parent's or legal guardian's consent to enter the Cricket Bursary.
12. Murdoch will notify Applicants in writing if they have received the Cricket Bursary.

## Assessment

13. After entering the Cricket Bursary, Applicants will be contacted to determine their cricket playing ability.
14. WACA will assess Applicants' cricket playing ability based on the Applicants' experience and references.
15. Assessment will need to occur before the Applicant will be granted the Cricket Bursary.
16. WACA's assessment of the Applicant's playing ability is final.

## The Cricket Bursary Benefits

17. Recipients of the Cricket Bursary will receive the following benefits (**Benefits**):
  - a. A placement in a local Perth cricket club facilitated and organised by the WACA.
  - b. Access to training facilities located at Murdoch's Perth Campus.
  - c. Access to community coaching accreditation and umpire accreditation courses run by the WACA.
  - d. Where applicable, access to professional development opportunities with the WACA.
  - e. Tickets to international and national cricket fixtures.
  - f. A 1 year gym membership to The Zone Fitness Centre located at Murdoch's Perth Campus.
  - g. An allowance of up to \$800 to cover club fees for the cricket club the Recipient is placed in.
  - h. 1x embroidered Murdoch cricket kit bag.
  - i. 1x guided tour of the WACA grounds.
18. In relation to the placement of a Recipient of the Cricket Bursary in a local Perth cricket club (pursuant to clause 17.a):
  - a. the WACA will determine the placement on the basis of the experience and playing ability of the Recipient;
  - b. the allowance of up to \$800 (pursuant to clause 17.g):
    - i. is only granted to the Recipient if the Recipient is allocated to a local Perth cricket club; and
    - ii. is determined and is at the sole discretion of the WACA;
  - c. the placement is at the sole discretion of the WACA and any decisions made by the WACA (including any assessments) are final;
  - d. if a placement is found for the Recipient, Murdoch will notify the Recipient and introduce the Recipient to a member of the selected cricket club; and
  - e. the placement is for the length of 1 year, including the playing season from October to March, and can only be extended by written approval from the WACA.
19. In relation to the granting of tickets to international and national cricket fixtures to Recipients (pursuant to clause 17.e), this will be determined and allocated by Murdoch on the basis of tickets that have been made available.
20. In relation to the Benefits stated in clause 17:
  - a. The Benefits provided by Murdoch and the WACA are at the sole discretion of Murdoch and the WACA.
  - b. The Benefits must be taken as stated and cannot be sold, transferred, exchanged or redeemed for cash or any other item.
  - c. If a Recipient disputes the Terms and Conditions, that Recipient will not be entitled to the prize and Murdoch may at its discretion award the Cricket Bursary to another Applicant in accordance with the Terms and Conditions or choose not to award the Cricket Bursary.

- d. If a Benefit stated in clause 17 becomes unavailable for any reason, Murdoch and/or the WACA may, but is under no obligation, to substitute a Benefit of like or equal value.
- e. Murdoch and the WACA take no responsibility for the loss of a Benefit or the inability of the Recipient to use the Benefit.
- f. Murdoch and the WACA make no representations or warranties as to the quality, suitability, or merchantability of the Benefits.

### **The Terms of the Cricket Bursary**

21. Further to clauses 17 and 20, the Recipient of a Cricket Bursary acknowledges and agrees to meet the following conditions during the term of any granted Cricket Bursary:
  - a. The Recipient will remain enrolled in the initial course of study at Murdoch for the full term of the Cricket Bursary, including:
    - i. not withdrawing from units or the course of study;
    - ii. not being terminated from a course of study at Murdoch;
    - iii. not transferring from Murdoch;
    - iv. not deferring or suspending their studies at Murdoch without Murdoch's approval; and
    - v. not abiding by Murdoch's fee payment requirements.
  - b. The Recipient's student visa status will not change.
  - c. The Recipient will maintain satisfactory academic progress (see the Coursework Regulations) for course enrolment at Murdoch.
  - d. The Recipient will maintain a high standard of conduct at all times.
  - e. The Recipient will agree to post three (3) social media posts during the playing season (between October-March of each year) featuring Murdoch.
  - f. The Recipient will sign a Murdoch talent release form.
  - g. The Recipient will abide by Murdoch's codes of conduct, policies and regulations.
22. If a Recipient breaches any of the conditions specified in clause 21 the Benefits of the Cricket Bursary may be revoked, at the sole discretion of Murdoch and the WACA.
23. The Cricket Bursary is for a term of 1 year, with the option to extend based on the length of course of study. Any option to extend the term of the Cricket Bursary is at the sole discretion of Murdoch and the WACA.
24. The Cricket Bursary may be combined with any of the International Welcome Scholarships offered by Murdoch.
25. If it is determined that a Recipient has provided misleading information and/or does not meet the Cricket Bursary eligibility criteria, Murdoch (at its sole discretion) may revoke a Cricket Bursary from a Recipient.
26. Murdoch and the WACA reserve their rights to decline to award a Cricket Bursary to an Applicant if, in its opinion, there are no suitable applicants.
27. The number of Cricket Bursary's awarded shall be at the sole discretion of Murdoch and the WACA.

### **Personal Data Use and Collection**

28. Murdoch will not use the Applicant's personal information for any other purpose than as stated in these Terms and Conditions without their consent unless required or authorised to do so by law. ### **Miscellaneous**

29. Murdoch and the WACA's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
30. Murdoch and the WACA (and its related entities, employees, contractors, servants or agents) shall not be liable for and accept no responsibility for any accident, loss, injury or damage to any individual or property arising out of any act or omission, whether negligent or otherwise in conjunction with the Cricket Bursary or the Benefits, occurring either during or after the term of the Cricket Bursary.
31. Participation in the Cricket Bursary constitutes the Applicant's unconditional agreement to and acceptance of the Terms and Conditions.
32. The Applicant is responsible for ensuring his or her familiarity with the Terms and Conditions.
33. Murdoch and/or the WACA's decision not to enforce a specific restriction does not constitute a waiver of that restriction or of the Terms and Conditions generally.
34. The Terms and Conditions of this competition are governed by the laws of Western Australia.
