

International Welcome Scholarship - Exceptions and Things to Note

Exceptions:

You are NOT eligible to receive this scholarship if you:

- are an Australian citizen or permanent residency visa holder;
- are not required to pay international student tuition fees;
- have received an Australian Government scholarship that covers all or part of your tuition fees; or
- are sponsored by a non-Australian Government funding body, under an agreement or arrangement that the funding body has with Murdoch.

Note that the Scholarship:

- will be credited to a recipient's Murdoch tuition fee account and cannot be accessed by the recipient;
- will not be extended beyond its prescribed duration or amount except to the extent explicitly stated in Murdoch's terms and conditions agreed by the recipient as part of accepting the scholarship ("Terms and Conditions"), or as otherwise notified by Murdoch to the recipient in writing;
- will not be applied to tuition fees that are incurred for:
 - Murdoch's units delivered through Open Universities Australia or FutureLearn; or
 - cross-institutional units completed with another university, or units undertaken at a Murdoch campus outside of Western Australia;
- only covers partial tuition fees and does not cover any other student expense;
- can be revoked at Murdoch's discretion if the recipient is awarded another Murdoch scholarship;
- can or will be revoked if the recipient fails to maintain satisfactory academic progress (see Coursework Regulation);
- will be revoked if the recipient defers the start of her or his studies beyond 2024;
- can or will be revoked in other circumstances outlined in the Terms and Conditions; and
- cannot be transferred to a Murdoch campus or partner outside Western Australian, or to another university.
