TERMS AND CONDITIONS - Westpac Young Technologists Scholarship,

As a successful recipient of a Westpac Young Technologists Scholarship, I agree to the following terms and conditions and understand that it is my responsibility to adhere to the following conditions:

1. The scholarship is not deferrable.
2. Recipients must accept an offer into a listed Murdoch course to receive this scholarship.
3. Successful applicants must maintain a credit average (Weighted Average Mark 65+) and progress through each year of the course in the normal manner for the duration of the Scholarship.
4. Awardees must be available to attend the Westpac Scholar Summit held interstate earlier in the year (travel and accommodation costs paid by the Foundation).
5. Recipients of the scholarship will be required to submit an outcome report at the end of each year.
6. The Scholar understands and accepts the responsibility of being a good and exemplary "ambassador" of Murdoch University and the Westpac Scholars program.
7. In the event that the Student engages in any conduct that would breach the University's Student Misconduct Statute or associated Student Discipline Regulations then this may lead to:
 - a. the University terminating the Scholarship and associated payments
 - b. the Student being required by the University to repay the pro-rata value of the Scholarship already received that is referable to the period after termination.
8. The Scholar will immediately notify the University of any significant adverse event that occurs in relation to the scholarship.
9. The Scholar will actively engage as an Alumni member of the scholarship program, which includes a commitment, at least for the first 12 months after the scholarship, to actively share their experience, attend Alumni events and promote the scholarship within their educational Institution.
10. The Scholar will complete an in depth report of their scholarship experience which can be used to promote scholarship experience by the University, Foundation or any 3rd party engaged by either entity.
11. The Scholar will allow for his / her personal information to be provided to the Foundation (or any third party engaged by the Foundation) and authorises the Foundation (or third parties engaged by the Foundation) to use that information for any purpose in connection with:
 - a. promoting the Scholarship Program or the Foundation;
 - b. operating and developing the Program.
12. The Scholar agrees that under no circumstances will the Foundation, Westpac Banking Corporation or any of their related entities be liable or responsible for any loss or damage incurred by the Scholar in relation to the Scholarship including (without limitation) any loss or damage incurred by activities pursued in connection with utilising the scholarship.

STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS

As a successful recipient of the **Westpac Young Technologists Scholarship**, I agree to the following terms and conditions and understand that it is my responsibility to adhere to the following conditions:

1. I must remain enrolled in a full-time, internal academic program offered by Murdoch University for the full duration of my scholarship, unless granted an exception for exceptional circumstances.
2. I must seek independent advice from the relevant authorities on the effect, if any, that the scholarship may have on my eligibility for income support; or any tax implications.
3. I must notify the Student Financial Support Office (SFSO) in writing immediately if I:
 - a. Wish to transfer to another academic program within the University.
 - b. Wish to transfer to another institution.
 - c. Seek a retrospective withdrawal from any units I have enrolled in.
 - d. Choose to defer my studies and/or apply for Approved Leave.
 - e. Wish to study abroad on a Murdoch University affiliated placement.
 - f. Discontinue full-time study.
 - g. Fail any units or achieve a weighted average mark of less than 65% in any semester
4. I understand that I will forfeit the Scholarship if I:
 - a. Terminate my enrolment.
 - b. Transfer to another institution.
 - c. Transfer from full-time to part-time study (unless I have been granted an exemption).
 - d. Fail to maintain credit average throughout the duration of the scholarship.
 - e. Fail to provide up to date contact and/or financial details to the SFSO when requested.
5. I agree and acknowledge that changes in my enrolment may make me ineligible to receive scholarship payments. In the case that I am deemed ineligible I may be placed on a breached status of six months without payment. This status would provide me with the opportunity improve my eligibility for reconsideration in the subsequent semester. This opportunity would occur only once for the duration of the scholarship, and is at the discretion of the SFSO and the donor.
6. I understand that continuing to receive payments that I am ineligible for will result in action taken by the university. In the case of receiving ineligible funds, I will be required to repay all ineligible payments to the SFSO within a 3 month period.
