



When you press enter, the Murdoch University Handbook should be in the top 3 options.




Once you've reached the next screen you will be need to **click** on "**Units**".

Filters: Location

On the left hand side of the Handbook Advanced Search Page, you will notice that you are able to apply a wide range of filters when searching for units.

To ensure successful selection of units please make the following adjustments to your search:

As we teach in multiple locations around the globe it is extremely important that you select **“Murdoch”** in the **Location** filter.


Filters: Teaching Period

After selecting the location filter, the next most important step is choosing the correct “Teaching Period”.

First, you will need to click on the “Teaching Period” option on the left-hand side of the page.

You will notice there are a lot of options that appear in the drop down menu you will need to select **one** of the following:

- If you are commencing your semester abroad in **February** select **Semester 1-S1**
- If you are commencing your semester abroad in **July** select **Semester 2-S2**



Filters: Attendance Mode

After selecting the Teaching Period filter, the next most important step is choosing the correct **“Attendance Mode”**.

First, click on **“Attendance Mode”**.
From the drop-down menu you will then **need** to select **“Internal”**.

Note: Although it is not recommended, Study Abroad an Exchange Students may select to study **one** unit in **“External”** mode if:

- They have consulted with and gained approval from the Inbound Mobility Officer and their home institution.
- They are enrolled in 12 Credit Points.


Filters: Unit Level – Undergraduate/Bachelor

The **first number** in a **Unit Code** (e.g. AIS110) indicates the level/year of the unit. Units that correlate to 1st year level will begin with a ‘1’, 2nd year a ‘2’ and so on.

If you are an **undergraduate/bachelors** student at your home institution, you may **only** select units in **levels 100 – 300** at Murdoch University.

To ensure that you are only shown undergraduate/bachelors level units **select levels 100, 200 and 300** on the left side panel.

Note: 300 Level units are final year at Murdoch University and we do not recommend taking these if you are in your first or second year of your bachelor’s degree.


Filters: Unit Level – Postgraduate/Masters

The **first number** in a **Unit Code** (e.g. AIS569) indicates the level/year of the unit. Units that correlate to 5th year level will begin with a '5', 6th year a '6' and so on.

If you are an **postgraduate/masters** student at your home institution, you may **only** select units in **levels 500 – 700** at Murdoch University.

To ensure that you are only shown undergraduate/bachelors level units **select levels 500, 600 and 700** on the left side panel.

Note: In some instances your home institution may permit you to take lower level units for credit. You must discuss credit transfer with your home institution if you wish to take units at a bachelors level.



What units can I take?

Murdoch University has no requirement that you take units which correspond to your field of study at your home university, nor does Murdoch have any requirement that you must take all of your units from one major. Some restrictions and quotas do apply in the fields of Media, Veterinary Science, Psychology and Chiropractic Science, and for all units, you **must** meet any individual pre-requisites.

If you are searching for a unit which corresponds to a requirement at your home university, you can try to search for similar keywords using the **Search** field. For example, if you are a business student and looking for an accounting related unit, you can type in part of the word, e.g. “**market**”. This will bring up all the units which have “market” in their title.

Note: there may be other units which are related to marketing, but not have the word “marketing” in their title.



Filters: Owing Discipline

You can then further filter your results by **clicking** on “**Owing Discipline**” and selecting the relevant major from the drop-down menu.

In this example we have chosen “**Marketing**” from the drop-down, and the results now show Marketing units that are level 100-300, taught Internally at Murdoch in Semester 1, 2021.

Note: there may be other units which are related to marketing, but not have the word “marketing” in their title.







Check: Requisites

Some units at Murdoch University have pre-requisites for enrolment. This means that you are required to have completed some previous studies in a relevant discipline in order to be able to understand and manage the unit content you will be studying.

When searching for units it is important that you **check the requisites section**, and **provide evidence** that you have completed **sufficient prior study** should you wish to enrol in a unit that has pre-requisites.

If a unit has a pre-requisite it will provide a **link** to the required unit that you must have completed in order to enrol. By clicking this link you can discover the unit outcomes that you will need to provide evidence of meeting in previous study.

Prerequisites

Please be aware that in order to be allowed entry into a unit at Murdoch, you must satisfy the prerequisites of the unit. Prerequisites indicate that a certain level of background knowledge is required in order to succeed in the unit, and exist to ensure that students are placed in appropriate units.

In most cases, the Student Mobility Officer (Inbound) will use your transcript to determine whether you have equivalent units in your academic history – in some cases the Unit coordinator will be contacted and their decision will be final.

If you would like to check your eligibility for units before you submit them for transfer credit assessment at your home university, you are welcome to contact us to get pre-approved for your units.
